Dear Mr. Phillips,

I'm very grateful you were able to bring our Oneida County eminent domain case before New York State's courts. Not only was the public kept out of our new hospital decision until "unknown others" decided it would forever alter 25 to 34-acres of downtown, now public information is also being withheld over a proposed hospital parking garage.

On April 19, 2021 I submitted the attached letter and form to Oneida County seeking their records regarding a parking garage related to the downtown hospital. My request was first acknowledged per the attached letter dated May 13, 2021, after which Mr. Pronteau and I had multiple conversations. Then on June 2, 2021 Mr. Pronteau provided a memory stick containing two appraisals (both of my property) and a transcript of the December 23, 2020 public hearing held by Oneida County on eminent domain. These documents were already in my possession, thus added nothing new to my understanding. No further information has been provided to date.

Numerous media reports (over six years) reveal a considerable amount of activity within the Oneida County government surrounding a new downtown hospital parking garage. Attached is a partial list of news headlines indicating this activity (Exhibit A attached). They also reveal \$3 million has been authorized by the Oneida County legislature for said parking garage planning and design.

I'm pretty confident that fulfillment of my FOIL request is not meeting the legal requirements as dictated by Article 6 (Sections 84-90) of the NYS Public Officers Law. It's also my belief there are <u>numerous land options for new parking facilities</u>, yet all the public has seen are a few illustrations showing a rectangular-shaped object created by hospital architects, that represent a 1,500-car parking garage placed on top of my business and properties!

Seeking discovery of Oneida County's documents (Exhibit B attached) regarding my government's work and communications are of paramount importance. They are records also critically important to our pending court case/appearance.

I've fully documented my actions in my attempts to procure these public records. Would you please advise what legal action(s) we may take to obtain these public records? My livelihood is at stake and additional discover is of paramount importance.
